WAIVER OF APPEARANCE IN CERTAIN MATTERS

Unless the Court directs otherwise, the Court will waive the appearance of Chapter 7 Trustees on a motion to dismiss for failure to attend the Section 341 meeting of creditors.

Unless the Court directs otherwise, the Court will waive the appearance of Chapter 7 Trustees

and their retained professionals at the final meeting of creditors if no objections have been filed and neither the Trustee nor any of the professionals is requesting compensation, including commissions or fees and expenses, in excess of \$10,000.00. If a party does not file an objection but appears at the final meeting of creditors, then the Court may adjourn the matter to a new hearing date and require an appearance.

Please note:

- Uncontested motions and adjournments will be heard first.
- Trials are held the last week of the month.
- Chapter 7 trustees' motions to dismiss for debtor's failure to appear at the 341 meeting are to be scheduled ONLY for available **Tuesdays at 11:45 pm.**
- Chapter 13 confirmation hearings are generally held the first Tuesday of the month at 11:00 a.m. Hearings as to the following motions may be included on the confirmation calendar: motions to modify confirmed chapter 13 plan; motions to reinstate chapter 13 case; and motions by debtor(s) to sell or refinance. Before filing, check that a confirmation calendar is in fact to be held on the date in question. You may check by contacting the Courtroom Deputy, or by visiting www.nyeb.uscourts.gov/cal_scheduling.html, and click on the link for Judge Craig.
- Telephonic requests for adjournment ON CONSENT must be made at least two days before the scheduled hearing, with follow-up correspondence confirming the consent to adjourn by all parties in interest. No ex parte requests for adjournment will be granted by telephone.
- **Appearance by phone:** Parties may request to appear by phone by calling Chambers and requesting a telephonic conference.
