

ADVERSARY PROCEEDINGS

Adversary proceedings are those actions governed by Part VII of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. To commence an adversary proceeding, the plaintiff must file the following:

1. A signed original complaint. The complaint must state if the matter is a core or non-core proceeding.
2. A signed [adversary cover sheet](#).

If the adversary proceeding is pending before Judge Eisenberg, the Plaintiff is responsible for submitting a proposed [Standing Pre-Trial Conference Order and Instructions](#). After the order is signed, the Plaintiff is to serve a copy of the order upon all parties and counsel to the proceeding. The order sets forth Judge Eisenberg's requirement that parties to the proceeding must file a joint preliminary pre-conference statement no later than five (5) days before the first pre-trial conference

The current fee for filing a complaint is \$250.00. If a debtor is the plaintiff, no fee is required.
